VINEYARD SOURCING

A Pact between distinct blocks of Coombsville vineyard, located in the eastern foothills south of Atlas Peak, and lots from Rutherford, Atlas Peak and Mount Veeder. Coombsville is Napa's newest appellation and Faust's home vineyard. The marine breeze from nearby San Pablo Bay provides a cooler climate than Napa's northern appellations allowing for slow, even ripening which results in excellent structure, dark fruit character and layered complexity. Secondary sourcing from Rutherford, Atlas Peak and Mt. Veeder provides nuances of red aromatics, richness, tannin structure and spice that results in a complex and harmonious wine.
